

TIPS FOR CANDIDATES FOR A SUCCESSFUL VIDEO INTERVIEW



Rehearse video interviewing techniques with friends and family



Test the video technology before the interview including camera, microphone, and volume



Remove clutter or other distractions from the background



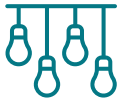
Choose a setting that is private and free from noisy disruptions



Dress appropriately and as if the interview was in person



Disable instant messaging, email, call, and text message alerts on your computer and phone



Make sure the lighting is just right (not too dark, not too bright)



Fully charge both your cellphone and computer beforehand



Assure you appear in the frame, have good posture, and are not too close to the camera



Log in to the interview early so you have time to resolve any technical issues



Practice pausing briefly after a question is asked to avoid talking over the interviewer



Deliver questions and answers while looking directly at the camera



Project your voice and speak clearly when responding to the interviewer



Conclude the interview by thanking the interviewer for the opportunity
